There are instances in music and poetry when, to complete or start a musical phrase, it is essential to begin before the downbeat. Wikipedia also reminds us that "a piece of music beginning with an anacrusis will also end before the last beat of the last bar, in order to keep the number of bars in the entire piece at a whole number."
